Mr H. NELSON gave a detailed account of his researches upon the fluvioglacial deposits at Riddarhyttan, Västmanland.

Mr O. SJÖGREN demonstrated with photographs and rock specimens some forms of wind- and glacierdenudation on Kirunavaara, Lapland.
